

See — Sea & Seed

After being held at Haeundae Beach, Gwangalli Beach, Songdo Beach, the Sea Art Festival 2015 turns its focus on Dadaepo Beach. Sowing the seed of art in a brand new space is an ambitious project. It is like growing plants by sowing the seed on a salty beach. Sea Art Festival 2015 has set two main goals. The festival will inspire the enjoyment of cultural art by local residents while also aiming to create an experimental contemporary art exhibition. In other words, this festival will germinate the seeds of the artist's creation and the visitor's enjoyment.

'See — Sea & Seed,' the theme of Sea Art Festival 2015 has a special significance. All citizens and artists are readily invited to a viewing (SEE) to get together (&) and share (&) the joy of art and sow the seeds (SEED) of art at a horizontal (—) exhibition space, Dadaepo Beach (SEA). Through this event, we are expecting that the concept of SHARING and AND (&) will spread to all places from Dadaepo Beach. The festival hopes to create a network where people and the sea, art and region and artists and citizens form lasting warm relationships.

The Sea Art Festival 2015 will show more than thirty artworks by international artists who were invited by the Artistic Director. A wide range of artists including elderly, leading, and emerging artists of the international contemporary art scene will participate. Along with a section called 'Scattering Seeds' occupying the trail, this year's show will display monumental sculptures above the waterfront as well as the 'Growing Seeds' section composed of an experimental installation that has reinterpreted the space by extending the scenery of Dadaepo Beach which is currently undergoing subway construction. The aim is incompleteness full of energy rather than a beautiful completeness.

Along with the vast horizontal (—) space of Dadaepo Beach, filled with experimental artworks, another horizontal (-) space of the semi-underground called the 'Germinating Seed_Imaginary Excavation Project' reinterprets the history of Dadaepo Beach, which was place of defense against the invasion of foreign countries, is a key point of viewing. In theses semi-underground containers, project type arts, media arts and installation works discovering and reinterpreting the time and space of Dadaepo from the past until now will be shown together. It is an art play of imagination to trace the beach's history under the name of 'Faction'. In this space, some plateaus and sand dunes (1) soaring up from the horizontal (—) space of the beach, the visitor gets to discover certain artworks of homage. The exhibition scenery of day and night, the curved exhibition guidelines and the special information center for visitors are also things to see at the Sea Art Festival 2015.

Lastly, various accompanying events for citizens and by citizens and artists such as an international symposium and citizen participation program to dignify this Sea Art Festival will be shown at the same time.

Exhibition Features

'See — Sea & Seed', the Exhibition Theme based on Storytelling

The exhibition theme of 'See — Sea & Seed' stands for creating and germinating the seeds of art, in other words the brand new art being created and germinated by exhibiting the artworks, at Dadaepo Beach which is a new place to hold the exhibition. The Sea Art Festival 2015 will be composed of a main exhibition of domestic and foreign artists invited by the artistic director as well as a special exhibition where a company from New Zealand (Peter LYNN Kites Ltd) will show artworks utilizing the natural environment and buildings in the surroundings of Dadaepo Beach. The main exhibition will be consisted of indoor exhibition that have utilized container boxes and the outdoor exhibition. Regarding its concept, it is divided into four sections titled 1)Scattering Seeds, 2)Germinating Seeds-Imaginary Excavation Project, 3) Growing Seeds, and 4) Growing Sea. The Sea Art Festival 2015 is planning to arrange the artworks based on storytelling including the seed and the sea that grow by being scattered and germinating. It is planning to transform Dadaepo Beach into a brand new place for art using the beach and the sea in addition to the surroundings of exhibition area, including the beach entrance.

Emergency of the Media Art and Media Facade that is Hardly Seen in Outdoor Exhibition

The Sea Art Festival 2015 will escape from the sculptures and installation artworks that had been ordinarily released in the past Sea Art Festivals to challenge in a brand new genre. Especially, we'll attempt a performance to overwhelm the vast seaside and a media art that has made the best use of the unique natural environment of Dadaepo Beach. The video artwork of Kyung-Ho LEE (Korea) projected on the walls of former Environmental Installation Corporation at the edge of beach and the laser art of Lee-Nam LEE (Korea) projected on the ridges of Molundae will set their position as the media facade of experimenting a brand new outdoor exhibition.

Collaborative Artworks to Cross the Boundary

If we were to choose the keyword of upcoming the Sea Art Festival 2015, it is definitely the 'collaboration'. We're planning to showcase various artworks of collaboration among artists, humanities, groups and audience, etc. In particular, we can speak of the collaborative artwork of an artist named Tae-Won OH (Korea) working together with a poet named Un KO, the <Love_1000 Dreams> by Ju-Hwan NOH (Korea) that gets produced with the pinwheels made by the children throughout the country, the <lmaginary Salt Pond> which is a collaborative artwork of the artists from four countries including Russia, France, U.S.A and Korea or the collaborative artwork of Archeology and Art from master's and doctor's course at the art graduate schools of Busan area, etc. We're looking forward to creating a mutual synergy beyond the limitations of outdoor exhibitions and drawing active interest of the general public by showcasing such collaborative artworks.

Audience Participatory Art and Performances

In case of the audience participatory performances, the main performance can be selected as the nomadic project of Rigdol TENZING(Tibetan American) which brings a pile of 100 bags of soil by passing though around 10 places from Incheon, past the inland, past East Sea and until reaching the South Sea as soon as the artist arrives at Incheon Airport from the United States to finally lay them out at Dadaepo Beach. This project has special significance as it includes the process of domestic and foreign artists and institutions greeting and sending off the artist together. Also, extraordinary performances such as a great kite flying performance, etc. with a New Zealand company (Peter LYNN Kites Ltd.) participating in the special exhibition has been planned to provide an unusual opportunity of appreciating artworks for the viewers.

All performances that take place in the upcoming Sea Art Festival 2015 become completed by the participation of audience. <Wish Tree> by Yoko ONO (U.S.A) that gets completed by hanging wishes of the audience on the tree could be called a typical example of audience participatory artwork. In addition, we'll need to focus our attention on the audience participatory artworks implemented by the performance of many participating artists including Andy DEWANTORO (Indonesia), Sun CHOI (Korea) and Chintan UPADHYAY (India), etc.

'Imaginary Excavation Project' to be decorated as a Space of Faction based

'Germinating Seeds (Imaginary Excavation Project)' is a major section among the four sections of the Sea Art Festival 2015. This section is focused on the meaning of 'germination'. The project reinterprets history through the actions of 'excavation' the historical imaginative power of Dadaepo Beach and reveals the process of a brand new art getting created through such discovery just like the dictionary meaning of 'germinate' which is to conceive a new life. It is to focus on the historical nature of Dadaepo Beach area where there had been frequent invasions of other countries through the 'Imaginary Excavation Project' and to contain a concept of 'faction' to ruminate this history at this point in time. In other words, each audience will have his or her own extraordinary experience through the Imaginary Excavation Project of the artists that intervenes the fictional imagination which interprets facts at the inside and the outside of seven container boxes.




